SoftForm Lighting Fabric Efficacy Evaluation

Methodology: SoftForm Lighting series type SFR22 9/16 ____ HO 40 120. Keeping the luminaire in a fixed location, five fixed photocells were positioned 3.5 feet from the fabric face. Position number 1 is directly below the center of the luminaire, positions 2 - 5, below each of the corners.

Four tests were conducted as follows:

- 1. Baseline without fabric
- 2. Plain white (HTW) fabric
- 3. Printed type SFG001
- 4. Printed type SFG008

Conclusion: Printing does have an impact on the system efficacy. Efficacy is proportional to the density of the ink used to render the image. Less dense (lighter) colors will enable greater efficacy. More dense (darker) colors result in less light transmission and therefore less system efficacy.
